This year we are once again planning to fly to Bristol and then onto Torquay via minibus. Depending on flight cost and availability we will either be flying with Flybe from Belfast city or Easyjet from Belfast international.

As with all low cost airlines, ticket prices increase as bookings increase and departure dates approach. This leaves us in the position that it is difficult to guarantee a firm price for camp. To minimise the impact of increasing flight costs we encourage everyone intending to go to camp to book as early as possible. We are therefore proposing a closure date of 26 Jan 2005, after which anyone wishing to attend camp will be charged £140 plus flights (which we will arrange). We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause. **So Please Book your place early**

Photographic ID. Although this and other details will be covered in future correspondence it is worth mentioning early. Airlines now require all passengers to produce photographic ID, which you will have to arrange for yourself. Acceptable forms of ID include.
